<p>Addition of harmful chemicals to natural water</p> <p>(Water pollution)</p>	<p>Destruction of forests</p> <p>(Deforestation)</p>
<p>A mixture of solid particles and gases in the air</p> <p>(Air pollution)</p>	<p>An escape of oil into the sea or other body of water</p> <p>(Oil spill)</p>
<p>A long-term rise in the average temperature of the Earth's climate system</p> <p>(Global warming)</p>	<p>A reduction in concentrations of ozone high above the earth in the stratosphere</p> <p>(Ozone hole)</p>
<p>The process by which radiation from a planet's atmosphere warms the planet's surface to a temperature above what it would be without its atmosphere</p> <p>(Greenhouse effect)</p>	<p>Radioactive waste is waste that contains radioactive material</p> <p>(Nuclear waste)</p>

<p>A form of precipitation that contains acidic components</p> <p>(Acid rain)</p>	<p>Waste material produced by industrial processes or activity.</p> <p>(Industrial waste)</p>
<p>Species which has been categorized as very likely to become extinct</p> <p>(Endangered species)</p>	<p>Gases ejected from an engine as waste products</p> <p>(Exhaust fumes)</p>
<p>Massive storm system that forms over warm ocean waters and move toward land</p> <p>(Hurricane)</p>	<p>An extended period of unusually dry weather with no rain or other precipitation</p> <p>(Drought)</p>
<p>A temporary overflow of water onto land that is normally dry</p> <p>(Flood)</p>	<p>A place where garbage is buried</p> <p>(Landfill)</p>
